

READY TO APPLY?

Local / Foreign Students

Congratulations on making the decision to begin your aviation career at LAU CE Aviation Program.

Below is the checklist of items necessary to apply to LAU CE Aviation Program. Students must also meet the minimum age requirements for each certificate pursued. All applicants will be subject for approval and are required to submit copies of ID or passport to be authenticated by our LAU CE office.

The Original documents that must be presented to enroll in the LAU CE Aviation Program:

- Application for Admission** – Applications and required documents must be completed and submitted at least 15 days before the upcoming Pilot's Pre-flight date. Please check with Admissions for submission deadlines.
- Copy of ID or ALL Passports Held** – All applicants are required to submit a passport copy for admissions office. If you have a citizenship or a residency in more than one country, you must submit a copy of all the passports issued to you.
- Proof of English Language Proficiency** – A minimum TOEFL score of 80 iBT (www.toefl.org) is required. Other English proficiency examinations will be considered.
- Copy of U.S. Resident Green Card** – (if any).
- Copy of Valid Driver's License**
- Police report** – New
- Proof of Education** – Applicants must possess an educational level equivalent to a Technical / High School diploma or higher.
- Copy of 2nd Class Medical Certificate** – LAU CE Aviation Program will send you to a (Lebanese Civil Aviation Authority) LCAA Medical Examiner in your area. No flight training can take place until the Medical Certificate is obtained.
- Copy of the Student Pilot Certificate and Logbook** – LAU CE will apply for your Student Pilot Certificate and logbook from the Directorate General of Civil Aviation – (DGCA Lebanon)
- Copy of Flight Certificate(s)** (if any are held)
- Student Review Form** (if applicant holds a Private Pilot License or other)
- Client Consent Form** (signed and completed in its entirety) – We want you to know how the information you provide to us is utilized. Please read and provide consent on the Client Consent Form. Please note that any information collected is typically required for LAU CE Aviation Program to provide regular approved training and services.

COMMONLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How accurate is the estimated timeline and pricing?

We do our best to make the estimated timeline and pricing as accurate as possible. Factors such as weather and student vacation requests can affect your graduation date and total tuition cost. Although, many students complete their training within the projected timeline and cost. We do recommend budgeting an extra 10% for additional flying hours required to achieve proficiency.

How soon should I begin the application process?

You should begin the application process at least one month in advance for local students and three months in advance for foreign students.

What is the Pilot's Pre-flight and Ground School?

Pilot's Pre-flight will be your introduction to LAU CE Aviation Program for one week. During this week you will be fully immersed into the training environment, and have your familiarization Cessna flight. This is meant to help new students understand the expectations and challenges of pursuing a career as a professional pilot.

Ground School classes are meant to provide students with all flight knowledge, procedures and academic content. Ground schools are usually held for 6 hours each day, Monday to Friday, from 8:00a.m.-12:00p.m. at Beirut International Airport MEA Hangar and 1:00p.m.-3:00p.m. at LAU Campus. CELL PHONES are not permitted during ground school.

Will students wear uniforms?

Uniforms are obligatory only at the airport. All students wear the standard uniform, which is NOT included in the tuition fees and consists of a white shirt with epaulets, blue pants, tie, wings, shoulder boards, and a nametag and could be found at LAU CE.

How often do classes begin and what is the capacity?

Each class includes 5 to 25 students and starts every month. Please contact us for more details on the Training Schedule.
